

Lymphedema of the arm

What is a lymphedema?

Lymphedema is a disease that can significantly limit the quality of life. Lymphedemas of the upper limbs mainly affect women as this medical condition mostly happens after breast cancerrelated removal of axillary lymph nodes. It is a painful disorder and it causes pain and heaviness in the affected limb. Lymphedemas are said to be unappealing and often are felt to be a huge burden, which can have a negative effect on the patient psychologically.

Compression therapy

Compression arm sleeves are used to prevent, treat and care for lymphedemas in the upper limbs. Numerous studies show that compression therapy is an effective treatment for arm lymphoedemas. It was also found that the wearing comfort and aesthetic appearance of the compression sleeve has a great influence on the compliance of the patient and the treatment effect.

The development of the ADVANCE arm sleeve

The ADVANCE arm sleeve was designed to meet the needs of patients, doctors and nursing staff. The new soft garment can in fact reduce volumes, even in maintained arms. This is possible due to the fact

that patients like wearing it and wearing it for longer.

Results

In the ADVANCE study, the following major criteria in objective measurement of efficacy of compression have been chosen:

Excess volume

The excess volume criterion represents a mean reduction in excess volume.

The reduction of excess volume criterion represents the percentage of arms affected for which such a reduction is observed.

In female patients with lymphedema, the upper arm is a sensitive and often painful part of the body where the sensitive skin is very easily irritated. It is used exclusively for ADVANCE and is therefore unique in the compression therapy of the arm.



Durable materials

In a direct comparison, wear-and-tear tests (see photo) revealed that the TRADITIONAL material is up to six times less susceptible to wear and tear than jeans (* = less sign of wear).



Excellent breathability

The large-mesh knit of the arm sleeve ensures high air permeability and breathability. This makes it demonstrably well suited for use in warm climatic conditions (confirmed by Swiss testing institute¹).



Excellent restoring force due to natural rubber

The use of threads containing natural rubber guarantees a maximum restoring force. Unlike synthetic materials, this arm sleeve returns to its original shape after being stretched, resulting in high pressure stability.

Good to know

Care

The arm sleeves should be washed by hand after wearing or at max. 40 °C with the gentle wash cycle in the washing machine in a laundry net. It is important to use a mild detergent without fabric softener. The Sigvaris Washing Solution is suitable for washing by hand.

To preserve maximum durability of the product, please inform your customers that we do not recommend using a dryer/heater. The arm sleeves must not be ironed or dry cleaned. The arm sleeves should be stored dry at room temperature away from direct sunlight.
